**10am – 12.30pm – Raymond Tce Craft Group** meets in the hall. Drop in for a cuppa, chat or some craft.

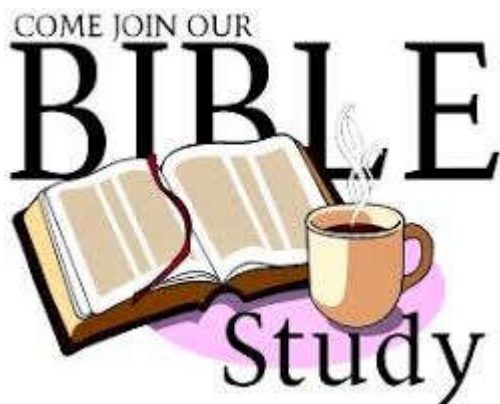


### **Fridays**

# Minister's intentional time with GC

In my August 31 minister's report, I wrote the following with the humble intention of doing ministry in an informal new way:

The question is: What new thing/s do we need to do together to change things around and better serve our pastoral needs and glorify God?

I know that something has to change – Either GC people change how we want to do things, or I change the way I'm doing ministry here in GC.

When I come back from my October leave; this is what I am going to do. As your minister, this is what I am offering:
